

## PUPIL PREMIUM

As a registered community special Hospital School we are not in receipt of Pupil Premium Funding.

**Pupil Premium (PP)** funding is designed to allow the school to help disadvantaged pupils by improving their progress and the exam results they achieve. As the Oxfordshire Hospital School (OHS) does not have a school roll, the annual return from which the Pupil Premium funding is calculated is not applicable.

Whilst registered with the OHS, pupils remain the responsibility of their enrolled school who will receive all additional funding including all money allocated for Pupil Premium.

During the last OFSTED Report, the following remarks were made:

“Although the school does not receive pupil premium funding for disadvantaged pupils, leaders rightly track this group of pupils very closely. Their progress matches and, in many cases, exceeds that of other pupils in the school.”
