Medical Stuff

- Double outlet right ventricle with VSD, malposed great arteries (aorta left in anterior)
- Sub-pulmonary and pulmonary stenosis
- Right aortic arch, bilateral SVC
- Straddling and overriding of the left AV valve
- Left BT shunt 10th July 2013 (complicated by left vocal cord paralysis)
- Bilateral bidirectional Glenn, take down of left BT shunt
- TCPC (extra-cardiac conduit, fenestrated)
- Cardiac catheter- fenestration re-opened Sept 18
- Oxygen saturation level was 74%
