

Y7 Catch Up Premium

As a registered community special Hospital School we are not in receipt of Y7 Catch Up Premium.

Y7 Catch Up Premium is funded by the Department for Education, with the purpose of supporting year 7 pupils who did not achieve [the expected standard](#) in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). As the Oxfordshire Hospital School (OHS) does not have a school roll, the annual return from which the Y7 Catch Up Premium is calculated is not applicable.

Whilst registered with the OHS, pupils remain the responsibility of their enrolled school who will receive all additional funding including all money allocated for Y7 Catch Up Premium.
