Dear Parents and Carers

You may be aware of recent concerns around misogynistic beliefs and behaviour among young people, particularly young men, linked to the online influencer Andrew Tate. Andrew Tate is an ex-kickboxer, reality TV contestant and social media personality who has become notorious for offensive views on women posted online. He is particularly popular among boys and several schools are reporting a rise in misogynistic incidents thought to be linked to Andrew Tate's influence. He also offers 'Get Rich Quick' schemes such as a website called 'Hustlers University', which costs around £40 per month and is reported to have been accessed by children as young as 13.

As parents and carers it is important to be aware of the name Andrew Tate and to understand his potential influence if you hear your children discussing him or viewing his content. You may wish to read [this BBC article](#) which provides some more information and explains what schools are doing to tackle the issue.

It is also important to be aware that, while he is currently the most high-profile, Andrew Tate is by no means the only online personality posting harmful content and is a useful reminder to monitor your children's online activity and to have open and honest conversations with them about what they are viewing.
